ORDINANCE NO. ____

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION (SA08-026) TO BUDGET AN ADDITIONAL \$115,000 FOR THE COURTHOUSE CHILLER PROJECT AND AN ADDITIONAL \$100,000 FOR THE GALLIANO OFFICE BUILDING CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF NEW AIR CONDITIONING UNITS WITHIN THE 2008 OPERATING BUDGET AND THE 2008 CAPITAL BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER SAID TRANSFERS.

WHEREAS, \$175,000 was originally budgeted in the 2007 Capital Outlay Budget for the purchase and installation of the chiller at the Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, this estimate of \$175,000 was an early preliminary figure determined by the administration after an initial meeting with the same engineer who worked on the Courthouse Annex Chiller project; and

WHEREAS, since that early initial estimate, the project engineer, while drawing up specifications for the project, came across a number of unforeseen issues that caused possible increases in overall costs; and

WHEREAS, after purchase of the chiller, the parish received bids on the installation of said chiller; and

WHEREAS, the bid received requires an additional \$115,000 for installation; and

WHEREAS, the air conditioning units at the old Wal-Mart building (where the Galliano Office Building is being constructed) are old and may need to be replaced before moving personnel into the building;

WHEREAS, this ordinance was sponsored for administration by, Councilman Louis Richard, District No. 3 and Councilman Daniel Lorraine, District No. 9,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Lafourche Parish Council, convened in regular session on _____, that:



ITEM 1

SECTION 1. A supplemental appropriation of the 2008 Operations and Maintenance Budget and the 2008 Capital Outlay Budget is hereby approved as follows:

Part I – 2008 Operations and Maintenance Budget

FUND 102 BUILDING MAINTENANCE

To transfer the additional funds needed to install the Chiller at the Historic Courthouse

1. an increase in TRANSERS OUT 299 in the amount of \$115,000

To transfer the additional funds needed for an air conditioning unit at the Galliano Office Building

1. an increase in TRANSFERS OUT 299 in the amount of \$100,000

Part II – 2008 Capital Outlay Budget

To budget the additional funds needed to install the Chiller at the Historic Courthouse

1. an increase in TRANSFERS IN 102 in the amount of \$115,000
2. an increase in CAPITAL OUTLAY in the amount of \$115,000

To budget for an air conditioning unit at the Galliano Office Building

1. an increase in TRANSFERS IN 102 in the amount of \$100,000
2. an increase in CAPITAL OUTLAY in the amount of \$100,000

SECTION 2. If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 3. All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Lafourche Parish Government Department of Parks, Recreation and Public Facilities, the Finance Department and the Office of the Parish Administrator.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:

RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN OPINION FROM THE LAFOURCHE PARISH DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO DETERMINE WHETHER A WEIGHT LIMIT ENACTED BY ORDINANCE ON A STREET CAN PREVENT RESIDENTS THAT LIVE ON THE STREET AND HAVE TRUCKS AND/OR EQUIPMENT THAT HAVE BEEN HOUSED AT THEIR RESIDENCE (PRIOR TO THE WEIGHT LIMIT ORDINANCE) WHICH NOW WOULD EXCEED THE WEIGHT LIMIT FROM USING THE STREET AS AN ACCESS IN AND OUT IN ORDER FOR THEIR BUSINESS TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE.
