- A.** ~~Political campaign~~ No signs of any kind shall ~~not~~ be erected, displayed or posted on any publicly owned property or right-of-way, or to or on any public utility pole or stanchion in Lafourche Parish.

- B.** Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment in the parish jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days, or by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by both such imprisonment and fine, at the discretion of the Court.

C.** Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment in the parish jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days, or by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by both such imprisonment and fine, at the discretion of the Court.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING UNTO VISION COMMUNICATION, LLC, A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA, HEREIN REPRESENTED BY ITS DULY ELECTED PRESIDENT, JAMES CALLAHAN, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE RIGHT AND THE PRIVILEGE TO ERECT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE TELEVISION TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES AND ADDITIONS THERETO IN, UNDER, OVER, ALONG, ACROSS, AND UP ON THE STREETS, LANES, AVENUES, ALLEYS, BRIDGES, HIGHWAYS, AND OTHER PLACES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF LAFOURCHE PARISH, LOUISIANA FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSMISSION BY CABLE AND TO DISTRIBUTE AND SELL COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES TO THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PARISH WITHIN ALL OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE PARISH, AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE, AND ADMINISTER SAID AGREEMENT AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A.** The Council of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana (hereinafter called "Parish"), hereby grants to Vision Communications, LLC (hereinafter called "Grantee"), its successors and assigns, the right and privilege to sell and supply communication services including cable television service and to use the lines for other purposes as may be approved by the Federal Communications Commission.

- B.** The rights and privileges granted Grantee herein shall terminate ten (10) years from July 1, 2008.
- C.** All of the rights and privileges and all of the obligations, duties and liabilities created by this franchise shall pass to and be binding upon the successors and assigns of Vision Communications, LLC without further action of the franchising authority.
- D.** This privilege shall not be exclusive and shall not restrict the Parish in any manner in the exercise of any privilege or other regulatory power which it now has or which it hereafter may be granted by federal, state, or local law.
- E.** This privilege shall coincide with any expansion of the unincorporated areas of the Parish of Lafourche.

SECTION 2. CONSTRUCTION

- A.** Grantee shall use due diligence to obtain all necessary permits and authorization without limitation, utility joint use agreements, microwave radio licenses and authorizations from appropriate Parish, state, or federal regulatory agencies.
- B.** Grantee's plant and equipment, including structures, poles, wires, cable and appurtenances shall be installed in accordance with good engineering practices, shall not endanger or interfere with the lives of persons or Parish property and improvements thereto and shall not unnecessarily or unreasonably hinder or obstruct pedestrian or vehicular traffic or cause interference with the proper use of streets, alleys, or other public ways and places. All installation shall be of permanent nature and shall be maintained in a safe condition.
- C.** In case of any disturbance of pavements, sidewalks, driveways or other surfaces by reason of construction or installation undertaken by Grantee, Grantee shall at its own cost and expense and in a manner approved by the Parish, within 30 days replace and restore such pavements, sidewalks, driveways, or other surfaces to the condition existing before the construction or installation was commenced.
- D.** Any opening or obstruction in the streets or other public ways made by Grantee in the course of the installation, operation, and maintenance or removal of equipment, structures, facilities, apparatus and appurtenances shall be guarded and protected at all times by the placement of adequate barriers, fences or boarding, the bounds of which, during periods of dusk and darkness, shall be clearly designated by warning lights. Whenever it is deemed necessary by the Parish, Grantee shall install steel plates to allow a public way to remain useable while openings or obstructions exist.
- E.** If at any time during the period of this Ordinance, the Parish shall elect to alter or change the grade of any streets, alleys, or public ways, Grantee, upon reasonable notice from the Parish, shall relocate conduits, manholes or other fixtures at its own expense.
- F.** Upon reasonable request from any person holding a building moving permit issued by the Parish, Grantee shall remove or lower wires it has installed to permit the moving of buildings. The expense of such temporary removal, raising or lowering of wires shall be paid by the person requesting the same, and Grantee shall have the authority to require such payment in advance.

- G. Grantee shall have the authority to trim trees which are located on or which overhang streets, alleys, sidewalks and public places of the Parish when coming in contact with wires or cable installed by Grantee. All such trimming is to be done at the expense of Grantee. Upon the termination of this privilege, Grantee promptly shall remove all of its equipment, structures, facilities, apparatus and appurtenances from the streets, alleys, sidewalks and public places in the Parish if requested to do so by the Parish and shall restore all such areas to their original condition.

SECTION 3. TECHNICAL STANDARDS

- A. In the construction, maintenance and operation of a cable television system, Grantee shall at all times fully comply with technical standards which or hereafter may be adopted by the Federal Communications Commission including, without limitation and if applicable, requirements relating to channel capacity, bandwidth ratios, return capacity and periodic testing. The technical quality of the cable television service provided by Grantee shall be sufficient to provide subscribers with uniformly high television reception. Grantee shall maintain its systems in good repair and working order at all times.
- B. Whenever it is necessary to shut off or interrupt service for the purpose of making repairs, adjustments or installation, the Company shall do so at such times as will cause the least amount of inconvenience to its customers, and unless such interruption is unforeseen and immediately necessary, it shall give reasonable notice thereof to its customers.

SECTION 4. CABLE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

- A. Grantee at all times shall provide the cable television services required to be provided by rules or regulations which have been or which hereafter may be adopted by the Federal Communications Commission including, without limitations and if applicable, programming originated by Grantee, public access, governmental, educational leased cable channels and the use of studio facilities and equipment.
- B. Grantee shall provide the signals of all television broadcast stations required to be carried by the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and subject only to the cable television systems channel capacity, the maximum number of additional television signals it is permitted to carry by such rules and regulations.
- C. Grantee may provide such additional audio and video services as it wishes, including services for which a per program, per service or per channel charge is made, as are consistent with the terms of this Ordinance and federal, state or local law.

SECTION 5. COMPLAINTS

- A. Grantee shall maintain an office or a designated agent either within the Parish, or within a neighboring community which can be easily reached by public transportation, for the purpose of receiving, investigating and responding to complaints from subscribers, Grantee shall make every reasonable effort to resolve complaints to the satisfaction of the subscribers.
- B. Upon receipt by the Parish of a complaint against Grantee, the Parish shall forward a copy to the local office of Grantee, within such time as may be prescribed by the Parish, Grantee shall satisfy

the complaint or advise the Parish of its refusal or inability to do so. If Grantee satisfies the complaint, it shall inform the Parish of the action taken. If Grantee is unable to satisfy the complaint, the Parish shall so notify the complainant and inform him of the procedure to be followed to file a formal complaint. Within ninety (90) days thereafter, the complainant may file a formal complaint with the Parish in the form and manner specified by the Parish. The Parish shall investigate the matters alleged in the complaint and thereafter may dismiss the complaint or may order Grantee to take such action consistent with the law as may be necessary to satisfy the complaint.

SECTION 6. PRIVILEGE FEE

- A. On or before thirty (30) days after the close of the six (6) month periods ending on December 31 and June 30, respectively, Grantee shall pay the Parish a privilege fee of three percent (3%) of Grantee's gross monthly receipts of basic subscriber charge plus three percent (3%) of the gross monthly premium channel receipts within the unincorporated areas of the parish during the preceding six (6) month period.
- B. The Parish shall have the right to inspect Grantee's reports from which the payments hereunder are computed and shall have the right to audit and recomputed the amount of such payments, if in error.
- C. Payments by Grantee to the Parish pursuant to foregoing provisions shall not be considered in the nature of a tax but shall be in addition to any and all taxes which are now or which hereafter may be required to be paid by any federal, state, or local tax.

SECTION 7. REVOCATION OF PRIVILEGES

If Grantee shall fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance or, except for causes reasonably beyond its control, default in any of its obligations hereunder, or if Grantee shall fail to commence correction of defaults or noncompliance within ninety (90) days of written notice thereof from the Parish, or fail to complete such operation within a reasonable time thereafter, the Parish may revoke this Ordinance and all rights of Grantee hereafter without notice. In the event Grantee shall be adjudicated bankrupt or a receiver be appointed for its assets, the Parish may terminate this Ordinances forthwith.

SECTION 8. INSURANCE

- A. Grantee shall obtain at its expense the following policies:
 - 1. A general comprehensive public liability insurance policy indemnifying, defending and saving harmless the Parish, its officers, commissions, agents or employees from any and all claims by any person whatsoever for injury to, or death of a person or persons occasioned or alleged to have been occasioned by the operations of Grantee under the privilege granted herein, in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.00 per personal injury or death of any one person and 2,000,000.00 for personal injury or death of any one occurrence.
 - 2. Property damage insurance indemnifying, defending, and saving harmless the Parish, its officers, boards, commission, agents or employees from and against all claims by any persons whatsoever for property damage occasioned or alleged to have been occasioned by the operation of Grantee under the franchise granted herein, in the amount of at least \$250,000.00 for property damage of any one person and \$1,000,000.00 for property damage of two or more persons in any occurrence.

- B.** All of the foregoing insurance contracts shall be in a form satisfactory to the Parish, shall be issued and maintained by companies authorized to do business in the State of Louisiana and accepted by the Parish and shall be kept in full force and effect by Grantee during the term of this Ordinance and until completion of all obligations of the Ordinance including any required removal of equipment, structures, facilities, apparatus, and appurtenances. The contracts shall contain provisions requiring a certificate of insurance be issued annually upon the renewal of the Policy, and that thirty (30) days written notice if any cancellation be given to both the Parish and Grantee. A copy of each policy shall be filed with the Parish by Grantee.

SECTION 9. INDEMNITY

Grantee shall fully indemnify, defend and save harmless the Parish, its officers, boards, commissions, agents and employees against any and all claims, suits, actions, liability and judgment, for damages to persons or property including without limitations, damages arising out of copyright infringement and out of the installation, operation or maintenance by Grantee of a cable television system whether or not any act or omission complained of, is authorized, allowed or prohibited by the franchise. Grantee shall pay all expenses, including attorney fees, personally incurred by the Parish in defending itself with regard to all such claims, suits, actions, liability and judgments.

SECTION 10. ACTIVITIES PROHIBITED

The Company shall not allow its cable or other operations to interfere with television reception of persons not served by the cable, nor shall it interfere with, obstruct or hinder in any manner, the operation of the various utilities serving the residents of the Parish. The Company shall not perform repair service to television sets and shall not permit any of its employees, installers or servicemen to perform such services on their own.

SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW

Grantee shall at all times comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Within one year of adoption by the Federal Communications Commission of modifications or additions to rules and regulations relating to the permissible terms of cable television privileges, this privilege shall conform to such rules and regulations.

SECTION 12. RENEWAL

The Parish may extend this franchise for another period of ten (10) years after due process.

SECTION 13.

That reasonable precautions and care shall be exercised by the Grantee so as to protect the public from any harm arising out of the construction, maintenance and operation of its cable system, and the Grantee shall at all times indemnify and save harmless the Parish for and from any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments, costs or expenses arising out of or by reason of the ownership, construction, maintenance and operations of Grantee's cable system, and nothing herein contained shall ever be held or construed so as to obligate grantor or the parish for the responsibilities and liabilities of Grantee and agrees to defend any suit brought against the Lafourche Parish Council as a result of this franchise.

SECTION 14.

If any section, part, paragraph, sentence or clause of this Ordinance should be declared invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or defect shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs, parts, sentences or clauses thereof and, to this end, the several provisions thereof are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 15.

All ordinances or parts thereof by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or in consistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 16.

SECTION 2:207 REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL EXPENSES FOR MEMBERS OF THE LAFOURCHE PARISH COUNCIL, COUNCIL EMPLOYEES, THE PARISH PRESIDENT, ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS OF PARISH BOARDS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES.

A. Members of the Lafourche Parish Council, Council employees, the Parish President, administrative employees, members of parish boards and their employees are authorized reimbursement in the following manner for expenses incurred while performing official duties:

1. ~~Reimbursement shall be made in accordance with the most current Louisiana Travel Guide available for reference at:~~

2. ~~Where circumstances require the approval of the Commissioner of the Division of Administration:~~
 - a. ~~Legislative officials and employees shall obtain the approval of the Council Chair:~~
 - b. ~~Members and employees of Parish Boards, Commissions, and Special Districts shall obtain the approval of either the Parish President or the Parish Administrator:~~
 - c. ~~Administrative officials and employees shall obtain the approval of either the Parish President or the Parish Administrator:~~

1. Boards that have administrators shall receive approval from their administrator regarding reimbursement for travel.
2. Boards without an administrator shall receive approval from the Parish Administrator or the Parish President regarding reimbursement for travel.
3. All Parish employees that travel shall receive approval from the Parish Administrator or the Parish President regarding reimbursement for travel.
4. All Lafourche Parish Council members that travel shall receive approval from the Lafourche Parish Council Chairman regarding reimbursement for travel.
3. ~~The following modifications are to be considered in application of the Travel Guide guidelines:~~
5. a. ~~As Parish officials and employees are not able to utilize state contracts for Air transportation travel shall be made using commercial carrier service at the coach/economy class rates. The Parish does not require use of lowest priced airfare where circumstances which can be documented dictate otherwise.~~
6. b. **Single Day Travel:** Travel out of the Parish or within the parish when over 30 miles away from a person's domicile that extends through lunch will be reimbursed in accordance with the Traveler's Meals chart **Meals are not eligible for reimbursements on single day travel. This means that when an authorized traveler of the Parish is in travel status where no overnight stay is required, no meals are eligible for reimbursement. Each Department Head or their designees are to determine when overnight travel is justified.**
 - a. **The Department Head will be allowed to authorize Single Day Meal reimbursements on a case by case basis or by type of single day travel when it is determined to be in the best interest of the department (employee is in travel status for 12 or more hours). In those cases the reimbursement will be reported as wages to the employee and paid on their payroll check and will be made based on receipt tickets furnished by the employee. Failure to furnish the receipt will prevent the employee from being reimbursed.**

7. Overnight Expenses

- a. Travel out of the Parish that requires overnight stay, room will be reimbursed the actual amount of a single room rate. Whenever a Parish employee or any board member under the jurisdiction of the Parish is required to stay overnight the employee or board member under the jurisdiction of the Parish is allowed a per diem of \$50.00 per day in-state and \$100.00 per day out-of-state for his or her expenses. The expenses covered by this per diem are as follows: meals, tips, cab fare, and parking fees, etc.**
- b. When traveling out-of-state or to another country, all Parish employees and board members under the jurisdiction of the Parish will be reimbursed actual cost for cab fares and parking fees.**

NUISANCE ABATEMENT CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2008 by and between **LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT** (hereinafter referred to as OWNER) with the current mailing address of P.O. Drawer 5548, Thibodaux, Louisiana, and **FORET LAND & TREE, LLC** (hereinafter referred to as CONTRACTOR/VENDOR) with the current mailing address of 1048 Canal Blvd Thibodaux, LA 70301.

IN CONSIDERATION of the covenants and agreements herein contained, OWNER and CONTRACTOR/VENDOR hereby contract with each other as follows:

1. CONTRACTOR/VENDOR agrees that it will perform all work and provide all services, labor, equipment, and materials more particularly set forth and identified in the contract documents for the following: Bid # 1 Nuisance Abatement 2008.
2. The work shall be performed in strict conformity with the contract documents and shall be provided and performed in a perfect and workmanlike manner free of any defects and/or deficiencies and free of all claims for liens.
3. The term of this Agreement shall commence from the date of the Notice of Award and extend for a period not to exceed December 31, 2008. OWNER may exercise an option to extend the Agreement for additional one (1) year periods, not to extend beyond the term of the current Parish President on date of signing.
4. OWNER shall pay CONTRACTOR/VENDOR for the performance of the work under this Agreement as follows: At rates and unit prices set forth in CONTRACTOR/VENDOR'S official bid form, *proposal and/or quote*.
5. CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless OWNER against all liabilities for the illness, injury, or death of a person(s), or the loss or damage to the property, equipment, or materials belonging to person(s), who is (are) a member(s) of CONTRACTOR/VENDOR and for the illness, injury, or death of person(s) or the loss or damage to the property, equipment, or materials belonging to OWNER.
6. This Agreement shall control and govern all activities of CONTRACTOR/VENDOR in connection with the work of employees and/or equipment of CONTRACTOR/VENDOR. This Agreement shall remain in effect until the term expires or Agreement is cancelled by either party giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice to that effect at the respective mailing addresses herein set forth. To protect OWNER against liability in connection with, or resulting from, the carrying out of this contract, CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall obtain and maintain at all times during the life of this contract, at the expense of CONTRACTOR/VENDOR, with reliable insurance companies, commercial liability, and contractual liability insurance with minimum limits as listed in "exhibit A" attached hereto. Said insurance will be endorsed as primary to any other insurance available to CONTRACTOR/VENDOR, cover the contract indemnity undertaking of CONTRACTOR/VENDOR, name OWNER as additional insured, provide for waiver of subrogation against OWNER, and provide for the giving of OWNER thirty (30) days written notice of cancellation. CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall obtain and maintain at all times during the term of this Agreement at the

expense of the CONTRACTOR/VENDOR, with reliable insurance companies, workers' compensation insurance with alternate employer endorsement in favor of OWNER, and waiver of subrogation in favor of OWNER. Should the work be on or near water, CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall obtain and maintain at all times during the term of this Agreement, at the expense of the CONTRACTOR/VENDOR, U.S. Longshoremen & Harbor Workers' Act coverage, Outer Continental Shelf Act Endorsement, with alternate employer and waiver of subrogation in favor of OWNER, in the minimum limits as per "Exhibit A" attached hereto per accident covering the injury or death to any employee. Prior to the commencement of work/services to be conducted under this Agreement, CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall furnish OWNER with certificates of insurance, evidencing the coverages and conditions required by this agreement and such certificates shall comply with "Exhibit A" of this Agreement. Commencement of work/services without the required certificates of insurance, or without compliance with any other provision of this Agreement, shall not constitute a waiver by OWNER of any rights to this Agreement.

7. In the event it becomes necessary for OWNER to engage the services of an attorney at law to enforce this Agreement or protect the interest of the OWNER hereunder, CONTRACTOR/VENDOR shall pay reasonable attorney's fees.
