“BAYOU SOLDIERS FUND” ESTABLISHED FOR FALLEN SOLDIERS FROM LAFOURCHE AND TERREBONNE

In last Thursday’s roadside bombing in Iraq, the lives of seven U.S. soldiers were lost, including four soldiers from Terrebonne and Lafourche parishes.

In an effort to help the families of these men, a memorial fund at Bank One has been set up by Councilmen Mark Atzenhoffer and Brent Callais. Donations to the “Bayou Soldiers Fund” can be made at any Bank One. The funds collected will be used to assist the families of Sgt 1st Class Kurt Comeaux of Raceland; Spc.
