Lafourche Parish Monitors Disturbance in Gulf

Lafourche Parish Government's OEP Department is monitoring this disturbance in the Gulf and will make decisions accordingly to further advisories from the National Weather Service.

While no evacuations have been called yet, Lafourche Parish Government Parish President, Charlotte Randolph, urges all citizens to prepare for any development of this disturbance. It is recommended that citizens clean around their property as much as possible and take actions to secure their property.

This is the time for citizens of Lafourche, especially those living in travel trailers, to begin reviewing their hurricane plans and getting ready. Resident in travel trailers should monitor this disturbance closely for any further development as these travel trailers are not rated for winds over 45 mph.

All citizens should continue to monitor local television and radio for further information from Lafourche Parish Government.
