### **Randolph Selected to National Committee**

Lafourche Parish President Charlotte Randolph has been selected to serve as a member of the Environment, Energy and Land Use Steering Committee for the National Association of Counties (NACo). Mrs. Randolph was nominated by LA Police Jury Association Director, Roland Dartez and appointed by NACo President Don Stapley. The nomination entitles President Randolph to serve one year on the committee.

As a committee member, President Randolph will be responsible for aiding in the development of NACo policy and achieving policy goals. She will also be dealing with several specific matters pertaining, but not limited to:
