Rain Causes Flooding in Areas of the Parish

Rainfall throughout the night has caused minor flooding in Lafourche Parish. Department of Public Works employees and officials with the Office of Emergency Preparedness are addressing these issues and monitoring water levels across the parish.

Reports have come in from the Golden Meadow area where one house has flooded and LA 1 is flooded at two places near the town. One business has flooded in Galliano and sandbags have been distributed to residents in the area. Two houses have flooded in the Raceland area near LA 182 on St. Patrick St. and St. Phillip St.. No homes in Lockport have reported flooding, but Nolan Toups subdivision, Charlie Wallace subdivision, Green Acres subdivision, and Fantastic Blvd. have water covering parts of the streets.

Pump operators have been working since last night to ensure that pumps across the parish are working properly and pump at their capacities. Officials will continue to monitor water levels, address the current flooding issues, and monitor weather reports to anticipate further rainfall.
