### Residents of Lafourche Parish – Recycling Drop-Off Program



Lafourche Parish Government is pleased to announce that Wal-Mart Supercenter(s) in Lafourche Parish have agreed to become the designated drop-off sites for recyclable materials. The recycle bins which were previously located at Region A Field Office, 2565 Veterans Blvd., Thibodaux, Region C Field Office, 6236 Hwy 308, Lockport, and SWDI, LLC, 201 W. 39<sup>th</sup> St., Larose are now located in the parking lots at each of the Wal- Mart Supercenters located in Thibodaux, Mathews, and Galliano.

It is expected that the new locations will be more convenient and accessible to residents wishing to continue their recycling efforts. The bins are available for use 24-hours/day, 7 days/week. Acceptable items include all paper (newspapers, office papers, cardboard, etc...), all types of plastics, tin cans, aluminum cans, aluminum foil. The program does not include any glass items. No sorting of items is required, however we do ask residents to place all items in the bins and not leave any material on the ground.
