Lafourche Parish Government Advises Caution

Lafourche Parish President, Charlotte Randolph, is advising citizens to exercise caution and continue monitoring Tropical Storm Arlene.

At this time the National Weather Service is advising reduced threats to Lafourche Parish. Should the storm track shift, other precautionary actions may be necessary. "We will continue to monitor the storm throughout the night and into tomorrow and be prepared to take any actions necessary to ensure the safety of the citizens of Lafourche Parish," said Parish President, Charlotte Randolph.

The current conditions do not warrant evacuation orders, but the possible flooding of LA 1 south of the hurricane protection system may temporarily isolate some areas.

Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office and Port Commission Harbor Police will be patrolling LA 1 from the Leon Theriot Flood Gate to Grand Isle to monitor water levels.
