

Lafourche Parish Government Tier Re-Entry Criteria

The tier re-entry process will take place following a wide-scale evacuation due to a catastrophic event when immediate re-entry by everyone is neither prudent nor possible. For smaller events, normal procedures will take effect.

The tier re-entry will be as follows:

Tier I- Police, Fire, EMS, DPW, Essential hospital staff and Utility Companies.

Tier II- Assessment teams (**which consist of 2 to 3 people**) of Critical infrastructures, major employers and other businesses that are determined by the Parish President to be essential to the return residents and/or to the economic vitality of the Parish.
Examples of Tier-2 re-entry eligible businesses include big-box retailers, debris management companies; financial institutions; food suppliers; pharmacies and medical suppliers; nursing homes; licensed construction companies; insurance companies; communication companies; chemical plants/refineries; hardware store; building material suppliers; lodging managers; security companies; American Red Cross; and Lafourche Parish-approved faith-based groups and other relief agencies.

Tier III- General Population. (No ID card issued)

****Only individual pictured on tier ID card will be allowed thru, No other individuals without tier Ids in vehicle will be permitted to pass.**

**** If traveling through other parishes or states to get to Lafourche Parish we advise you to follow the La. State Police's re-entry plan.**

The tier entries will be implemented when the Parish President, in consultation with the Director of Emergency Management and local law enforcement agencies, determines that roadways are clear and safe for travel.

Tier badges do not guarantee road passage. It will be to the discretion of local law enforcement agencies to allow passage once the roadways are deemed to be safe for travel.

Companies found to be issuing credentials to non-employees or non-essential employees will be subject to suspension of their re-entry privileges.

If an employee quits, retires or is terminated, the employer must retrieve badge from the employee and notify the Lafourche Parish OEP Department.

During the catastrophic event you can access information on when each tier levels are implemented thru local media and also at the Lafourche Parish Government website which is: www.lafourchegov.org.
