

CHAPTER 22
RETIREMENT AND PENSION PLAN

Sub-Chapter A

Social Security

SECTION 22:1. DECLARATION OF INTENTION TO HAVE POLICE JURY ENROLLED IN SOCIAL SECURITY

It is hereby declared to be the policy and purpose of Lafourche Parish to extend the provisions of Section I, Act No. 204, Regular Session, Louisiana Legislature of 1952, providing Social Security to eligible employees and officers of Lafourche Parish. The coverage of eligible employees shall be retroactive to July 1st, 1951. In pursuance of said policy, and for that purpose, the officers of Lafourche Parish shall take such action as may be required by applicable state or federal laws or regulations. (Ord. No. 862, 11/12/52)

Comment -- On January 14, 1976, the Police Jury adopted a resolution declaring its intention to terminate social security coverage on its employees as authorized by Act. No. 538 of 1968 and Act. No. 441 of 1974. The termination is to become effective April 1, 1978.

SECTION 22:2. PRESIDENT AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH PUBLIC EMPLOYEES BOARD

The President of the Police Jury of Lafourche Parish is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the Public Employees' Board of Louisiana to secure coverage of eligible employees as provided in Section 22:1. (Ord. No. 862, 11/12/52)

SECTION 22:3. EMPLOYEES CONTRIBUTIONS; WITHHOLDINGS FROM WAGES

Withholdings from salaries or wages of employees for the purposes provided in Section 22:1 hereof are hereby authorized to be made in the amounts and at such time as may be required by applicable state and federal laws and regulations, and shall be paid over to the state agency in such amounts and at such times as are designated by state laws and regulations. (Ord. No. 862, 11/12/52)

SECTION 22:4. EMPLOYERS CONTRIBUTIONS; ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

Employer contributions and administrative expenses shall be paid to the state agency in accordance with applicable state laws and regulations from amounts appropriated for such purposes. (Ord. No. 862, 11/12/52)

SECTION 22:5. SECRETARY-TREASURER TO MAINTAIN RECORDS AND PREPARE REPORTS

The Secretary-Treasurer shall maintain such records and submit such reports as may be required by applicable state and federal laws or regulations. (Ord. No. 862, 11/12/52)
