

**ORDINANCE NO. 3590, ENACTED ON APRIL 26, 2005, RESCINDED**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 3533**

**AGREEMENT WILL NOT BE PROCESSED UNTIL AFTER THE STATE  
FINISHES THE PROJECT.**

The following ordinance was submitted for introduction by Mark Atzenhoffer, in regular session convened on December 14, 2004.

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

The following Ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Brent Callais, seconded by Mark Atzenhoffer:

**ORDINANCE NO. 3533**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING OWNERSHIP OF WHATEVER RIGHTS THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT MAY OWN IN AND TO THE AFORESAID PORTION OF LOUISIANA HIGHWAYS AS A BINDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF LOUISIANA AND PARISH OF LAFOURCHE PROVIDED THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMPLIES WITH THE CONDITIONS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE THE INSTRUMENTS TO TRANSFER THE AFORESAID PROPERTY ONCE THE CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT ARE MET.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on January 11, 2005 that:

**SECTION 1.**

**WHEREAS**, the Lafourche Parish Council on July 13, 2004 (Resolution 04-068) expressed its interest in accepting the ownership and rights to six sections of Louisiana Highways in Lafourche Parish; and

**WHEREAS**, unacceptable conditions in said resolution prompted the Lafourche Parish Government to meet with officials of the Louisiana Department of Transportation regarding these streets and their transfer into the parish system; and

**WHEREAS**, at the recommendation of the parish administration, the Lafourche Parish Council does wish to accept a portion of **Louisiana Highway 1** into the Lafourche Parish system of streets from the newly constructed exit ramp on the west side of Bayou Lafourche at Leeville to the intersection of State Route LA 3090 at Fourchon less and except the existing bridge across Bayou Lafourche upon the completion of a minimum two inch overlay of the entire length of said roadway conducted after the completion of the LA 1 relocation;

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, that the Lafourche Parish Council does hereby authorize the Lafourche Parish President to sign, execute and forward a letter of commitment and ultimately a transfer of **Louisiana Highway 1** into the Lafourche Parish system of streets from the newly constructed exit ramp on the west side of Bayou Lafourche at Leeville to the intersection of State Route LA 3090 at Fourchon less and except the existing bridge across

Bayou Lafourche upon the completion of a minimum two inch overlay of the entire length of said roadway conducted after the completion of the LA 1 relocation;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that resolution 04-068 is hereby rescinded and a certified copy of this ordinance be forwarded to the Governor of the State of Louisiana; to Jim Porter and Tom Payment at the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, P.O. Box 94245, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70804-9245; Lafourche Parish Legislative Delegation; and the Lafourche Parish Department of Public Works.

**SECTION 2.** If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
