

The following ordinance was submitted for introduction by Mr. Mark Atzenhoffer, in regular session convened on October 11, 2005.

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

The following Ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Mark Atzenhoffer, seconded by Dr. Tommy Lasseigne:

**ORDINANCE NO. 3690**

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 3535 AS IT PERTAINS TO ACCEPTING OWNERSHIP OF WHATEVER RIGHTS THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT MAY OWN IN AND TO THE AFORESAID PORTION OF LOUISIANA HIGHWAY 656 (KNOWN AS LAKE LONG DRIVE) AS A BINDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF LOUISIANA AND PARISH OF LAFOURCHE DUE TO THE PARISH ALREADY OWNING SAID PROPERTY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on October 25, 2005 , that:

**SECTION 1.** Lafourche Parish Ordinance No. 3535 as it pertains to accepting ownership of whatever rights the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development may own in and to the aforesaid portion of Louisiana Highway 656 (known as Lake Long Drive) as a binding agreement between the State of Louisiana and the Parish of Lafourche, is hereby rescinded due to the parish already owning said property.

**SECTION 2.** If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
