

The following ordinance was submitted for introduction by Mr. Michael Matherne, in regular session convened on February 14, 2006.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The following Ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Michael Matherne, seconded by Mr. Lindel Toups:

ORDINANCE NO. 3756

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN SPECIAL EDUCATION DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE PARISH OF LAFOURCHE, STATE OF LOUISIANA, ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2006 TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF A SPECIAL TAX THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Special Education District No. 1 of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Special Education District No. 1 of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on February 2, 2006, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, **September 30, 2006**, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Parish Council to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Parish Council of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Special Education District No. 1 of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana, this Parish Council hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, **September 30, 2006**, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION
(MILLAGE RENEWAL)

SUMMARY: 10 YEAR, 4.98 MILLS PROPERTY TAX RENEWAL FOR ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, MAINTAINING OR OPERATING THE FACILITIES OF THE DISTRICT.

Shall Special Education District No. 1 of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana (the "District"), levy a four and ninety-eight hundredths (4.98) mills tax on all the property subject to taxation in the District for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2007 and ending with the year 2016, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating the facilities of the District?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Parish Council does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein.
