**RESOLUTION NO. 04-045-A**

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING A LEGAL OPINION FROM THE LAFOURCHE PARISH DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THE PARISH CAN LEGALLY ESTABLISH A DECLARATION OF PUBLIC POLICY WHEREBY THE LAFOURCHE PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY CONFIRM THE AUTHORITY OF THE LAFOURCHE PARISH PRESIDENT, THE PARISH ADMINISTRATOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES TO SUPERVISE, MANAGE AND WHEN NECESSARY, DIRECT EMPLOYEES OF THE LAFOURCHE PARISH COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY, INCLUDING ITS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Lafourche Parish Council, convened in regular session on June 08, 2004, that it does hereby request a legal opinion from the Lafourche Parish District Attorney to determine whether or not the Parish can legally establish a declaration of public policy whereby the Lafourche Parish Council does hereby confirm the authority of the Lafourche Parish President, the Parish Administrator and the Director of the Department of Community Services to supervise, manage and when necessary, direct employees of the Community Action Agency, including its Executive Director.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Lafourche Parish District Attorney, P. O. Box 431, Thibodaux, LA 70302; Office of the Parish Administrator; Lafourche Parish Community Services; and the Lafourche Parish Community Action Agency.
