RESOLUTION ASKING THE LAFOURCHE PARISH DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO RESEARCH THE ST. LOUIS CANAL DAM LAWSUIT IN COOPERATION WITH TERREBONNE PARISH AND THE POSSIBILITY OF DOING WORK ON THE DAM TO ALLEVIATE THE DRAINAGE SITUATION WHICH EXISTS AT THIS TIME.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on March 24, 2009, that it does hereby ask the Lafourche Parish District Attorney to research the St. Louis Canal Dam lawsuit in cooperation with Terrebonne Parish and the possibility of doing work on the dam to alleviate the drainage situation which exists at this time.
