RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT (LADOTD) LOOK INTO THE DRAINAGE ISSUES ON HIGHWAY 182 AT THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARIES OF RACELAND, LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, the Lafourche Parish Council has made and continues to make requests to the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development which concerns the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty upon oath that the Governing Authority and State Officials address concerns dealing with the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens and said resolution satisfies this criteria; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on May 12, 2009, that it does hereby request the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD) look into the drainage issues on Highway 182 at the southern boundaries of Raceland, Louisiana.
