RESOLUTION NO. 09-200

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT (LADOTD) (2ND REQUEST) TO INSTALL LIGHTS, SIGNS, OR AN ACCEPTABLE ALTERNATIVE AT THE FOLLOWING: 1ST LOCATION: BAYOU BLUE LOWER ELEMENTARY; 2ND LOCATION: LAFOURCHE PARISH PUBLIC COMPLEX (BAYOU BLUE MIDDLE SCHOOL, LIBRARY, DAY CARE CENTER, RECREATION BUILDING, SENIOR CITIZENS COMPLEX, FOUR (4) BALL FIELDS, THE RUNNING TRACK AND THE FUTURE LOCATION OF DISTRICT 5 FIELD OFFICE AND ALL MAJOR INTERSECTIONS WITHIN ONE (1) MILE OF ANY PUBLIC BUILDING; (MAY CONSIDER COMBINING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL WITH TRAFFIC CONTROL LIGHTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 182 AND HIGHWAY 316, PARISH OF LAFOURCHE, STATE OF LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, the Lafourche Parish Council has made and continues to make requests to the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development which concerns the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty upon oath that the Governing Authority and State Officials to address concerns dealing with the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens and said resolution satisfies this criteria; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on June 9, 2009, that it does hereby request the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD) (2ND request) to install lights, signs, or an acceptable alternative at the following: 1st location: Bayou Blue Lower Elementary; 2nd location: Lafourche Parish Public Complex (Bayou Blue Middle School, Library, Day Care Center, Recreation Building, Senior Citizens Complex, Four (4) Ball Fields, the Running Track, and the future location of District 5 Field Office and all major intersections within one (1) mile of any public building; (may consider combining elementary school with traffic control lights at the intersection of Highway 182 and Highway 316, Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, Attn: Mr. Michael Stack, District Administrator, Post Office Box 9180, Bridge City, Louisiana 70096-9180; Lafourche Parish Legislative Delegation; Lafourche Parish Department of Public Works, and the Office of the Parish Administrator.
