RESOLUTION REQUESTING A RULING FROM THE LAFOURCHE PARISH DISTRICT ATTORNEY REGARDING THE EXEMPTION OF TOLLS ON THE NEW TOMMY DOUCET BRIDGE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on July 28, 2009, that it does hereby request a ruling from the Lafourche Parish District Attorney regarding the exemption of tolls on the new Tommy Doucet Bridge.
