

On motion by Lindel Toups, seconded by John Arnold, the following resolution was introduced and adopted;

RESOLUTION NO. 14-120

RESOLUTION APPROVING A STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT AND THE SOUTH LOUISIANA REGION OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS WITH RESPECT TO MASS CARE CANTEEN SERVICES PROVIDED TO PRE-LANDFALL HURRICANE EVACUATION PROCESSING LOCATIONS AND POST-LANDFALL EVACUEE RETURN LOCATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER SAID AGREEMENT AND ANY AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, this Statement of Agreement is intended to identify roles and responsibilities of Lafourche Parish and the South Louisiana Region of the American Red Cross (ARC-SOLA) with respect to mass care canteen services provided to pre-landfall hurricane evacuation processing locations and post-landfall evacuee return locations; and

WHEREAS, The South Louisiana Region of the American Red Cross will drop through a vendor, bottled water and snacks to Thibodaux High School which is the evacuation processing location at 1355 Tiger Drive, Thibodaux, LA 70301; and

WHEREAS, Lafourche Parish is responsible for distributing all bottled water and snacks to evacuees; and

WHEREAS, this resolution was sponsored for Administration by Mr. Lindel Toups, Councilman, District 6; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Administration of the Lafourche Parish Government that the Council approves the Statement of Agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and the South Louisiana Region of the American Red Cross for mass care canteen services provided to pre-landfall hurricane evacuation processing locations and post-landfall evacuee return locations and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said agreement and any and all relevant documents.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on May 13, 2014, and does hereby approve the Statement of Agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and the South Louisiana Region of the American Red Cross for mass care canteen services provided to pre-landfall hurricane evacuation processing locations and post-landfall evacuee return locations and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute, and administer any and all relevant documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to American Red Cross, South Louisiana Region, Attn: Kay Wilkins, 2640 Canal Street, New Orleans, LA 70119; Lafourche Parish Government Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, Department of Finance, and the Office of the Parish Administrator.
