

The following ordinance was introduced by Mr. Daniel Lorraine in regular session convened on July 22, 2014.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The following ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Jerry LaFont, seconded by Mr. Michael Delatte.

ORDINANCE NO. 5509

ORDINANCE APPROVING A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT AND BAYOU CIVIC CLUB, INC. TO ALLOW LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT TO UTILIZE THE LAROSE CIVIC CENTER AS AN EVACUATION SHELTER IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCIES AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER SAID LEASE AGREEMENT AND ANY AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Bayou Civic Club (BCC) desires for the Parish to act as fiscal and disbursing agent when requesting State and Federal financial assistance relating to natural disasters and declared States of Emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the BCC files PWs individually as it relates to facility damages; and

WHEREAS, Lafourche Parish Government, through its Parish President, during an emergency event in the Parish, is empowered to take the steps and measures necessary to protect the lives and property of the citizens of Lafourche Parish; and

WHEREAS, the Parish is responsible for emergency preparedness operations including providing shelters of last resort; and

WHEREAS, in the 1978 application CIEP funds in the amount of \$850,000.00, it was stated, "The Civic Center will be constructed of hurricane resistant materials and design and will be offered to the Parish Civil Defense authorities as an emergency shelter; and

WHEREAS, Lafourche Parish Government and the Bayou Civic Club, Inc. wish to memorialize an agreement to grant the use of the Larose Civic Center as an emergency shelter; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was sponsored for Administration by Mr. Jerry LaFont, Councilman, District 8; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Administration of the Lafourche Parish Government that the Council approves a Lease Agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and Bayou Civic Club, Inc. to allow Lafourche Parish Government to utilize the Larose Civic Center as an evacuation shelter in the event of emergencies and authorizing the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said lease agreement and any and all relevant documents.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Lafourche Parish Council convened in Regular Session on August 12, 2014, and hereby approves a Lease Agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and Bayou Civic Club, Inc. to allow Lafourche Parish Government to utilize the Larose Civic Center as an evacuation shelter in the event of emergencies and authorizing the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said lease agreement and any and all relevant documents.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Bayou Civic Club, Inc, attn: Ms. Jasmine Ayo, Executive Director, PO Box 1105, Larose, LA 70373; Lafourche Parish Government Department of Community Action; Department of Finance, Office of Risk Management, and the Office of the Parish Administrator.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that;

SECTION 1. If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items or application of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
