On motion by Phillip Gouaux, seconded by Lindel Toups, the following resolution was introduced and adopted;

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-208**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC HEALTH CENTER FOR COMMUNITY PREPAREDNESS (CCP) AND LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FOR THE CITIES READINESS INITIATIVE (CRI) AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE, AND ADMINISTER SAID CONTRACT AND ANY AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Public Health Center for Community Preparedness is offering said contract to Lafourche Parish in order to provide participation in Strategic Nation Stockpile (SNS)/Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) collaborative planning that will enhance 48 hour mass dispensing response capabilities and foster partnerships which will in turn meet the CRI program deliverables through planning meetings, conference calls, etc.; and

**WHEREAS**, other services provided including the following:

- Identifying parish planning leads and develop a written draft of the 48 Hour Mass Antibiotic Dispensing Plan (formerly local SNS/CRI plan) annex to the existing parish all hazards plan that meets the CRI program deliverables; and
- Will continue to identify issues through meetings with parish partners and possibly neighboring parishes; and
- Will facilitate, implement and /or participate in all exercises and drills listed including 3 POD drills, 1 tabletop exercise or workgroup session.

**WHEREAS**, said contract shall commence on July 1, 2014 and terminate on June 1, 2015, with a maximum contract amount of \$20,115.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution was sponsored for Administration by Mr. Phillip Gouaux, Councilman, District 7; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended by the Administration of the Lafourche Parish Government that the Council approves a contract with the Office of Public Health Center for Community Preparedness (CCP) and Lafourche Parish Government Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness for the Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said contract and any and all relevant documents.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on August 12, 2014, and does hereby approve a contract with the Office of Public Health Center for Community Preparedness (CCP) and Lafourche Parish Government Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness for the Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said contract and any and all relevant documents.
