RESOLUTION NO. 14-203

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA WORKFORCE COMMISSION TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO THE LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNING BOARD IN MANAGING, DIRECTING AND OVERSEEING ALL ASPECTS OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICE BLOCK GRANT OF THE LAFOURCHE PARISH OFFICE FOR COMMUNITY ACTION AND TO ALSO PROVIDE THE LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNING BOARD WITH RECOMMENDATIONS MANDATING THE PROGRAM GUIDELINES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE LOUISIANA WORKFORCE COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Lafourche Parish Governing Board to request the assistance from the Louisiana Workforce Commission to improve the management, development of programs and expenditures until it is deemed that the Parish can provide a high quality of community services for the residents of Lafourche Parish; and

WHEREAS, the Parish President, the Parish Council and all appropriate staff thereof be directed and authorized to aid and assist the Louisiana Workforce Commission in carrying out the intent and function of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this resolution does not in any way or manner, modify the current statutory obligations/responsibilities of the Parish as it relates to the current or future of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Programs and any such changes or modifications shall require specific future documents/agreements accepted by both parties and which are deemed to be in the best interest of Lafourche Parish; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lafourche Parish Council, which convened in regular session on August 12, 2014, that it does hereby request the Louisiana Workforce Commission to provide guidance to the Lafourche Parish Governing Board in managing, directing and overseeing all aspects of the Community Service Block Grant of the Lafourche Parish Office for Community Action and to also provide the Lafourche Parish Governing Board with recommendations mandating the program guidelines as recommended by the Louisiana Workforce Commission; therefore

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Louisiana Workforce Commission; the Lafourche Parish Government Office of Community Action and the Office of the Parish Administrator.
