

The following ordinance was introduced by Mr. Lindel Toups in regular session convened on September 23, 2014.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The following ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Lindel Toups, seconded by Mr. Phillip Gouaux.

ORDINANCE NO. 5535

ORDINANCE TO ABANDON A THIRTY (30') FOOT WIDE BY SEVENTY (70') FOOT LONG STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY WHICH HAS NEVER BEEN DEVELOPED LOCATED BETWEEN LOT 5 OF BLOCK 6 AND LOT 1 OF BLOCK 7 FACING ST. PATRICK STREET IN THE RACELAND AREA WARD 3 DISTRICT 6 ON PLAT ENTITLED "E. L. BREAUX SUBDIVISION" RECORDED IN THE CLERK OF COURTS OFFICE IN THE PARISH OF LAFOURCHE, STATE OF LOUISIANA, UNDER ENTRY NUMBER 152152 WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Lafourche Parish Council, convened in Regular Session on October 14, 2014, that:

SECTION 1. The Parish of Lafourche, through the Lafourche Parish Council, does hereby abandon and set aside all right, title and interest in and to a thirty (30') foot wide by seventy (70') foot long right-of-way in Ward 3, District 6

WHEREAS, said Ordinance does hereby abandon said right-of-way to said street in the Clerk of Courts Office in Lafourche Parish, State of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned street has never been developed; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is abandoning right-of-way in the Raceland area of Ward 3, Councilmatic District 6, Lafourche Parish.

WHEREAS, the Administration requests authority to sign off on the Ordinance in abandonment of said right-of-way;

WHEREAS, this ordinance was sponsored for Administration by Lindel Toups, Councilman, District 6

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Lafourche Parish Council does approve the abandonment of said right-of-way and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said agreement.

SECTION 2. If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items or application of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
