On a motion by Daniel Lorraine, seconded by Phillip Gouaux, the following resolution was introduced and adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 14-314

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT AND SECOND HARVEST FOOD BANK OF GREATER NEW ORLEANS AND ACADIANA TO DISTRIBUTE COMMODITIES MADE AVAILABLE BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PURSUANT TO 7 USC 612C TO ELIGIBLE SOUP KITCHENS, FOOD BANKS, FOOD PANTRIES, EMERGENCY FEEDING ORGANIZATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH 7 CFR PART 250 AND 251 AND THE HUNGER PREVENTION ACT OF 1988, P.L. 100-435; AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER SAID AGREEMENT AND ANY AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, Second Harvest of Greater New Orleans and Acadiana offers programs to implement distribution of commodities made available by the United States Department of Agriculture to eligible soup kitchens, food banks, food pantries, and emergency feeding organizations; and

WHEREAS, this program services the Lafourche Parish area by providing commodities for low-income households in Lafourche Parish; and

WHEREAS, this program is administered under direction of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Food Bank Program; and

WHEREAS, in this agreement, Lafourche Parish Government is designated as the “Food Bank” and Second Harvest is designated as the “Food Pantry;” and

WHEREAS, this resolution was sponsored for Administration by Mr. Daniel Lorraine, Councilman, District 9; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Administration of Lafourche Parish Government that the Council approve an agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and Second Harvest Food Bank of Greater New Orleans and Acadiana to distribute commodities made available by the United States Department of Agriculture pursuant to 7 USC 612c to eligible soup kitchens, food banks, food pantries, emergency feeding organizations in accordance with 7 CFR Part 250 and 251 and the Hunger Prevention Act of 1988, P.L. 100-435 and authorizing the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said agreement and any and all relevant documents.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lafourche Parish Council convened in regular session on October 28, 2014, and does hereby approve an agreement between Lafourche Parish Government and Second Harvest Food Bank of Greater New Orleans and Acadiana to distribute commodities made available by the United States Department of Agriculture pursuant to 7 USC 612c

to eligible soup kitchens, food banks, food pantries, emergency feeding organizations in accordance with 7 CFR Part 250 and 251 and the Hunger Prevention Act of 1988, P.L. 100-435 and authorizing the Parish President to sign, execute and administer said agreement and any and all relevant documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to Second Harvest Food Bank, 700 Edwards Avenue, New Orleans, LA 70123; Lafourche Parish Office of Community Action, Department of Finance, and the Office of the Parish Administrator.
