

The following ordinance was introduced by Mr. Phillip Gouaux in regular session convened on November 25, 2014.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The following ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Jerry LaFont, seconded by Mr. John Arnold.

ORDINANCE NO. 5574

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TO SURPLUS AND DONATE PROPERTY AND ANY AND ALL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT THEREON LOCATED AT 205 MAIN STREET, LOCKPORT, LA 70374 (KNOWN AS THE LAFOURCHE PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS BUILDING) AND AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER ANY AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the above described property was acquired by Lafourche Parish Government under entry number 260980 on May 16, 1966 and approved by Lafourche Parish Police Jury on May 11, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned property has been used for many years by the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office as their Communications Office; and

WHEREAS, the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office has relocated their Communications office to another location leaving this building vacant; and

WHEREAS, Administration suggests to surplus the property and donate the property and any and all improvements and equipment located at 205 Main Street, Lockport, LA 70374 (known as the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office Communications Building); and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was sponsored for Administration by Mr. Phillip Gouaux, Councilman, District 7; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Administration of the Lafourche Parish Government that the Council authorizes to surplus and donate the property and any and all improvements and equipment thereon located at 205 Main Street, Lockport, LA 70374 (known as the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office Communications Building); and further authorize the Parish President to sign, execute and administer any and all relevant documents.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Lafourche Parish Council convened in Regular Session on December 9, 2014, and hereby authorizes to surplus and donate the property and any and all improvements and equipment thereon located at 205 Main Street, Lockport, LA 70374 (known as the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office Communications Building); and authorizes the Parish President to sign, execute and administer any and all documents.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to; Town of Lockport, Attn.: Mayor Paul Champagne, 710 Church Street, Lockport, LA 70374; Lafourche Parish Government Department of Finance, Office of Risk Management, and the Office of the Parish Administrator; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that:

SECTION 1. If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions, items or application of this ordinance which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
