

The following ordinance was submitted for introduction by Mr. Michael Delatte in regular session convened on November 25, 2014.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The following Ordinance, having been previously introduced and published, was offered for final adoption by Mr. Jerry LaFont seconded by Mr. John Arnold.

ORDINANCE NO. 5572

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEN (10) MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON PETER AND PAUL WAY (*WHOSE NAME IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE FROM YEAR TO YEAR*), FORMERLY KNOWN AS HOLY ROSARY CEMETERY STREET, LAROSE, LOUISIANA, WARD (10), DISTRICT (8), PARISH OF LAFOURCHE, STATE OF LOUISIANA; PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF “SPEED LIMIT” AND “SPEED CHECKED BY RADAR” SIGNS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Lafourche Parish Council, convened in regular session on December 9, 2014, that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance does hereby establish a ten (10) miles per hour Speed Limit on Peter and Paul Way (*whose name is subject to change from year to year*), formerly known as Holy Rosary Cemetery Street, Larose, Louisiana, Ward (10), District (8) of Lafourche Parish, State of Louisiana; providing for the placement of “Speed Limit” and “Speed Checked By Radar” signs; and providing penalties for the violations thereof.

SECTION 2. The necessary “Speed Limit ” and “Speed Checked By Radar” signs shall be erected as deemed necessary on Peter and Paul Way.

SECTION 3. The Sheriff of this Parish is hereby specifically requested to assist in the enforcement of the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of these regulations shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of these regulations.

SECTION 5. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment in the Parish jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days, or by fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by both such imprisonment and fine, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances by the Lafourche Parish Council conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be published in the Office Journal of the Lafourche Parish Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance, having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Council, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows:
