



Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery

Lafourche Parish has CDBG-DR grant awards for projects resulting from Hurricane Ida in 2021 totaling \$43,385,290.00. Please see below for a list of these projects.

Program Milestones and Deadlines

- Final Application Submission – October 15, 2026
Includes allocating unobligated funds for approved projects.
- Design Start – January 31, 2027
- Design Completion - January 31, 2028
- Construction Start – March 31, 2028
- Construction Completion - March 31, 2030
- Economic Development Last Service - March 31, 2030
- Closeout Completion – September 30, 2030

- Award: \$12,909,988.00
- Project: Build the Irvin “Scuppy” Jones Community and Head Start Center to consolidate the Head Start buildings and add a community center
- Status: Project is 100% designed, the environmental assessment is complete, and the Authority to Use Grant Funds and Notice to Proceed have been received
- Parish Project: Lady of the Sea Medical Clinic
 - Program: HUD/Resilient Communities Infrastructure Program (RCIP)
 - Award: \$11,847,215.40
 - Project: Build a Medical Clinic for Lady of the Sea General Hospital to serve the Larose community with increased services including a pharmacy
 - Status: CMAR project is 30% designed and pricing is under review
